As of first quarter of 2023, only 7.22% of the target enrollees and 8.43% of the target graduates have been recorded. Among the regions, Region II has contributed the most enrollees with 11.66%, while NCR has the highest share of graduates with 11.30% of the total output.

As of December 2022, the top three (3) regions with the highest enrollment in institution-based programs are NCR with 6,976 enrolled (18.92%). Following closely is Region III, with 3,972 enrolled (10.77%), and Region VII with 3,385 enrolled (9.18%). When it comes to enterprise-based programs, Region X takes the lead with 1,142 enrolled students, which accounts for a substantial 25.86% of the total enrollment in this training venue. NCR follows with 892 enrolled (20.20%), and Region II with 655 enrolled, contributing 14.83% to the total enterprise-based enrollment. For the community-based, Regions II, CARAGA, and X have the most number of enrollees with an average of 10%.

The top three (3) regions with the most number of graduates in institution-based programs are NCR with 11,203 graduates (22.50), Region III with 4,582 graduates or 9.20%, and Region IV-A with 4,114 graduates (8.26%). For the enterprise-based programs, Region X has the most graduates with 3,354 graduates or 25.58% of the total enrollment in this category, followed by Region III with 2,046 graduates (15.60%), and Region II with 1,305 graduates (9.95%). When it comes to community-based training, Regions II, CARAGA, and VII have the most number of graduates.

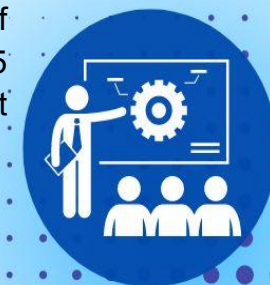

As part of TESDA's response to the extensive lockdown measures imposed during the pandemic, TESDA issued Circular No. 062, s. 2020, also known as Guidelines in implementing Flexible Learning Delivery in TVET. With this, various flexible learning delivery modes were implemented, including Face-to-face, Online, Blended, Distance, or a Combination of Distance and Face-to-face Learning. For the institution-based training, the most number of enrolled was implemented through face-to-face learning with a total of 24,088 enrolled or 65.33% of the total enrolled of the institution-based training. Moreover, as mentioned in the previous table, the regions with the highest number of enrolled students in institution-based training were Regions NCR, III, and VII.

Additionally, the highest number of graduates for institution-based training was also achieved through Face-to-face learning, totaling 25,848 graduates, which accounts for 51.92% of the total graduates in this training venue. It is worth noting that there are more graduates than enrollees. This discrepancy can be attributed to the spill-over effect from the 2022 enrollees.

The data on the Monitored programs are the “skills training programs that have TVET components conducted by other National Government Agencies (NGAs) and other skills training that has to be reported to TESDA. Some of these are from NGAs’ conducted skills training programs, TVL track graduates, DepEd Alternative Learning System (ALS), and others. According to Table 8a, 32.62% of enrollees in the Monitored programs came from the TVL Track, while 16.18% participated in training through NGAs’ skills training programs. Furthermore, other TVET programs reported to TESDA have recorded 50.30% of the total enrollment of monitored programs.

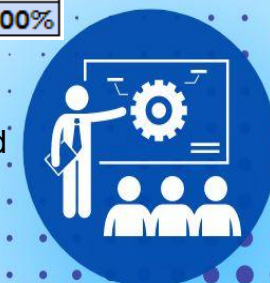

For the 1st quarter, the Public TVET Providers have recorded 45.07% higher than the Private TVET Providers in terms of enrolment and 21.20% higher in terms of graduates.
