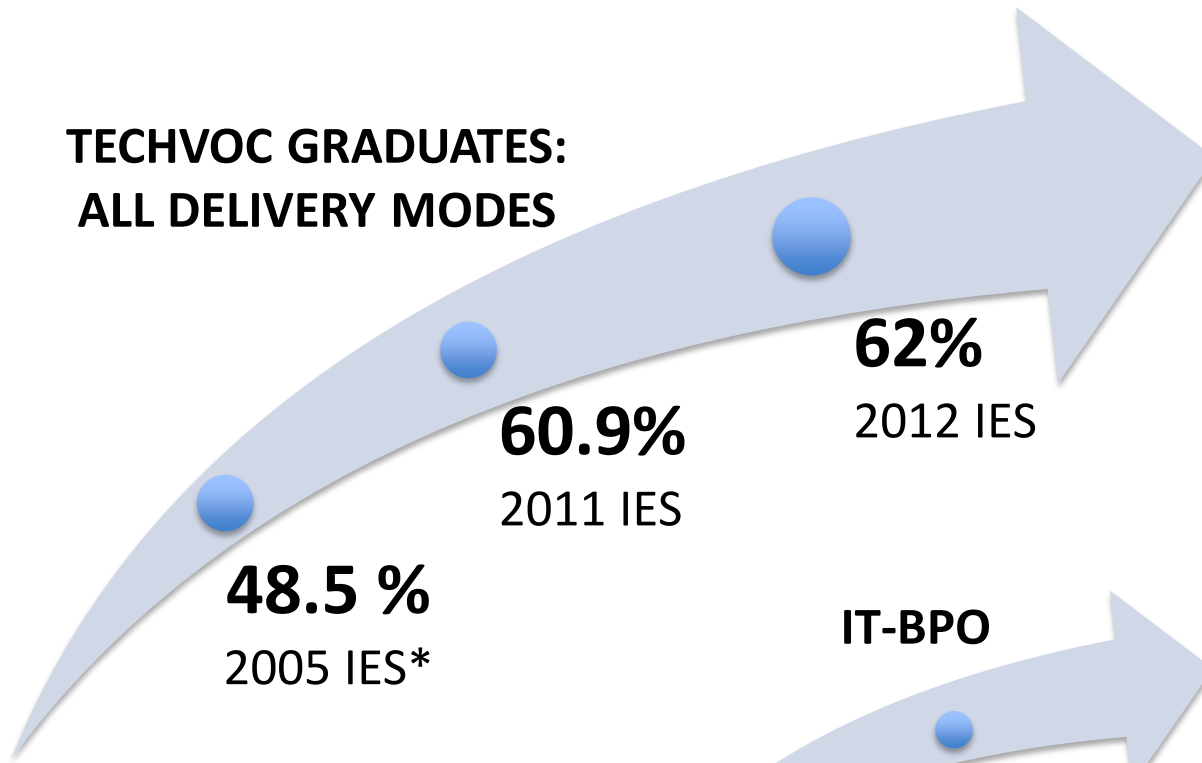

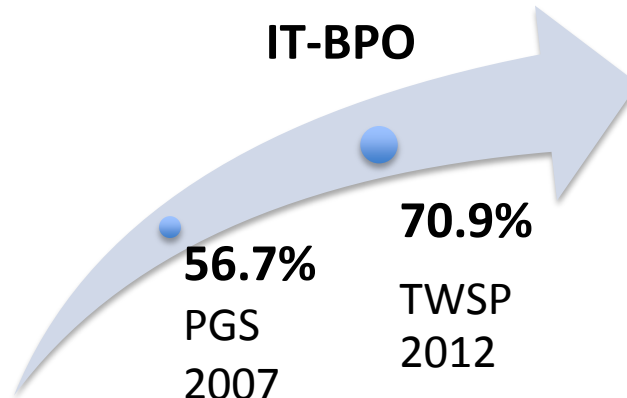

EMPLOYMENT RATES OF TECHVOC GRADUATES

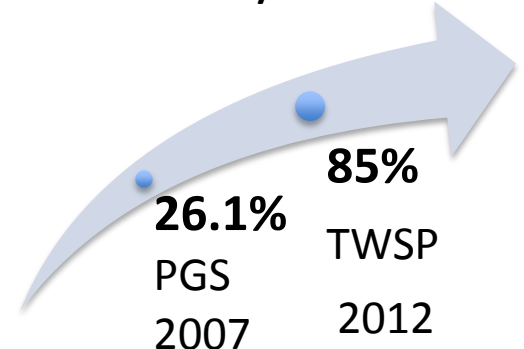
TECHVOC GRADUATES: ALL DELIVERY MODES
