

OVERSEAS DEMAND: JANUARY TO MAY 2010

he Philippine Overseas and Employment Administration (POEA) for the past years has been monitoring and releasing data on Filipinos in-demand overseas in the form of Job Orders. These Job Orders are requests from employers abroad for Filipino professionals and skilled workers. These are considered active unless cancelled by the employer or recruitment agency

For the period January 1, 2010 to May 31, 2010, the total job order was 249,721. Thirtythree percent (33%) or 82,311 were filled-up or processed leaving a balance of 167,410 (67%) unfilled job orders. Of the occupations/skills that remained unfilled, the Transport Equipment, Production and Related Workers posted the highest at 63,646 (38%) followed by Service workers at 57,068 (34%). According to POEA skills in these sectors are difficult to fill in due to lack of qualified skilled workers at the time being (Table 1).

Of the 249,721 job order overseas, 157,716 or 63% are skilled workers. The remaining balance of 92,005 or 37% are professional and related occupations. The Health, Social and Other Community Development Services workers constitute 73,198 (46%) of the total skilled jobs. This is followed by Construction Sector contributing 42,229 (27%) overseas jobs. The POEA Administrator said that in the Middle East a rise in job orders in the construction industries was noted because of the mega cities that are being built. Footwear and Leathergoods Sectors comprised the least in-demand occupations needed overseas at 0% or 8 jobs (Table 2).

Filipino skilled workers are in-demand in eighty (80) different countries. By country of destination, Saudi Arabia is still the top destination place of Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs) at 44,656 or 28.3% of total job orders. Qatar ranks 2nd at 27,282 (17.3%) followed closely by United Arab Emirates (UAE) at 24,842 (15.8%) The top 10 country of destination composed 143,860 or 91% of the total job orders for skilled Filipino workers [Table 3].

Table 4 below shows the top 10 occupations being sought overseas and its corresponding TVET Qualifications. Domestic Helpers and Related Household Workers is still the in-demand occupation at 52,821(33%) job orders. Waiters, Bartenders and Related Workers ranks far 2nd at 7,413 (5%) followed closely by Plumbers and Pipe Fitters at 7,192 (5%). The unfilled slots for Waiters and Bartenders as well as Plumber and Pipe Fitters are 5,263 (71%) and 5,390 (75%), respectively.
