RESOLUTION NO. 95-3

APPROVAL OF THE PROPOSAL MAKING THE QUEZON CITY POLYTECHNIC A PILOT INSTITUTION TO DEMONSTRATE THE CAPABILITY OF LOCAL GOVERNMENTS TO ASSUME TRAINING RESPONSIBILITIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 29 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7796 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE TESDA ACT OF 1994

WHEREAS, Section 29 of Republic Act No. 7796 provides that TESDA shall pursue measures to develop the capability of local government units to ultimately assume the responsibility of effectively providing community-based technical education and skills development opportunities;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Polytechnic was established by the Quezon City Government as a response to the critical need for skilled manpower in the city;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, through the Hon. City Mayor Ismael A. Mathay, has signified its intention to make the Quezon City Polytechnic a part of the TESDA network and, as such, be considered as a pilot institution to demonstrate the capability of local government units in assuming training responsibilities;

WHEREAS, the TESDA Secretariat has indicated its willingness and readiness to pursue this relationship with the Quezon City Government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED that the TESDA BOARD approve the inclusion of the Quezon City Polytechnic in the TESDA network and consider it as a pilot institution to demonstrate a process in the devolution of training responsibilities to local government units in accordance with Section 29 of Republic Act No. 7796;


BE IT RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the implementation of the resolution shall be covered by a memorandum of agreement which shall be approved by the Board;
