RESOLUTION NO. 95-6

EXPRESSING THE COMMITMENT OF THE TESDA BOARD TO INITIATE AND PURSUE THE UPGRADING OF THE SALARIES OF OFFICIALS, FACULTY AND EMPLOYEES OF PUBLIC TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT INSTITUTIONS TO THE SAME LEVEL BEING RECEIVED BY OFFICIALS, FACULTY AND EMPLOYEES OF CHARTERED STATE UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES

WHEREAS, there exists considerable disparity between the salaries of officials and employees of public technical education and skills development institutions and those in chartered state universities and colleges;

WHEREAS, technical instructors and trainers in said institutions possess similar industrial or technical expertise and instructional capability as those in chartered state universities and colleges;

WHEREAS, there is a need to make the compensation, emoluments and other benefits of officials and employees of public technical education and skills development institutions competitive to attract highly-qualified instructional staff;

WHEREAS, National Compensation Circular No. 69, series of 1993 needs to be reviewed and/or modified to make it more applicable to technical education and skills development, recognizing industrial experience and technical inventions more heavily than advanced academic degrees alone;

WHEREAS, there is a need to reiterate the compensation policy which was previously approved by the Department of Education, Culture and Sports;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED that the TESDA Board commits itself to initiate and pursue the upgrading of the salaries of officials, faculty and employees of public technical education and skills development institutions to the same level as those in chartered state universities and colleges;


BE IT RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the TESDA Secretariat be tasked to review and recommend modifications to National Compensation Circular No. 69, series of 1993;

BE IT RESOLVED, FINALLY that a copy of this resolution be furnished the Chairman of the Civil Service Commission and the Secretary of the Department of Budget and Management for their information and comments.
