RESOLUTION NO. 95-7

DECLARING THE POLICY THAT TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT INSTITUTIONS SHALL BE ENCOURAGED TO SET UP BUSINESS CENTERS AND PRODUCTION LINES PRIMARILY FOR TRAINING AND SHALL BE ALLOWED TO RETAIN AND USE ANY INCOME DERIVED FROM EDUCATION- AND TRAINING-RELATED INCOME-GENERATING PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS

WHEREAS, Republic Act 7663 otherwise known as the General Appropriations Act provides that DECS supervised post secondary institutions shall retain and use income from manufacturing and other entrepreneurial activities in support of educational programs of schools to attain a balance between education and production;

WHEREAS, income from such education-related projects shall accrue to the technical school or training center to be utilized for management of the projects, purchase and maintenance of equipment, and payment of honoraria of faculty and employees directly involved in the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED, that the TESDA BOARD declare the policy that technical education and skills development institutions shall be encouraged to set up business centers and production lines primarily for training and shall be allowed to retain and use any income derived from education- and training-related income-generating programs and projects;


BE IT RESOLVED, FURTHER that the TESDA Secretariat shall be tasked to develop simplified procedures for the approval of project proposals and for monitoring and evaluation of such projects;

BE IT RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the TESDA Secretariat shall ensure that the implementation of said policy shall be appropriately covered in subsequent general appropriations laws.


