RESOLUTION NO. 95-10

EXPRESSING THE COMMITMENT OF THE TESDA BOARD TO SUPPORT AND ASSIST PRIVATE TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT INSTITUTIONS THROUGH A SCHEME DESIGNED TO DEVELOP THEIR EDUCATIONAL AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT DELIVERY SYSTEM CAPABILITY

WHEREAS, private technical education and skills development institutions are considered as partners of government in providing technical education and skills development opportunities for the Filipino youth since a considerable number of students and trainees are in these institutions throughout the country;

WHEREAS, private technical education and skills development institutions have repeatedly expressed their need for government assistance in the performance of technical education and skills development services which are properly government functions and which are essential components in the government's thrust for socio-economic progress;

WHEREAS, the TESDA Board, in its Resolution No. 95-6, has expressed its commitment to pursue the upgrading of salaries of officials, faculty and employees of public technical education and skills development institutions;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED that the TESDA Board commit itself to support and assist private technical education and skills development institutions through a scheme designed to develop their educational and skills development delivery system capability;

BE IT RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the TESDA Secretariat be tasked to formulate the assistance scheme and generate sources like scholarship grants, foreign government grants, soft loans facility, etc. for the above-mentioned assistance to private technical education and skills development institutions;

BE IT RESOLVED, FINALLY, that copies of this RESOLUTION be furnished the President, the Senate President, the Speaker of the House, the Director General of NEDA and the Secretary of the Department of Finance for their information and guidance.
