 Certification Board, Workers Guild and Industry Boards, Organizers for Skills Competition.

WHEREAS, to provide continuity to the various activities of the Committees, a three-year term for its members is necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED, that the expansion of functions of the Technical Education and Skills Development Committees (TESDCs) be approved and the members appointed for a tenure of three years.;
