ADOPTING AND IMPLEMENTING THE TRAINING
REGULATIONS FOR GARMENTS OCCUPATIONS
(Garments Sewer [Industrial Sewing Machine Operation], Pattern Maker,
Production Supervisor and Product Developer)

WHEREAS, education and training in the garments sector is one of the critical factors in enhancing workers' competence and skills to meet the manpower requirements in the industry;

WHEREAS, TESDA is responsible for improving the sufficiency and efficiency of middle level manpower through training and education of industry workforce;

WHEREAS, TESDA Advisory Panel and Experts Panel (TAP and TEP) for the Garments Sector were organized to determine the occupational requirements, curriculum and assessment tests for the Garments Sewer (Industrial Sewing machine Operation), Pattern Maker, Production Supervisor and Product Developer Occupations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board approves the Training Regulations for the Garments Occupations for adoption and implementation to ensure the competitiveness of the workforce.


