RESOLUTION NO. 99 - 01

ADOPTING AND IMPLEMENTING THE TRAINING
REGULATIONS FOR THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY OCCUPATIONS
(Data Encoder, Computer Programmer,
Computer Technician and Network (LAN) Technician)

WHEREAS, a TESDA Advisory Panel and Experts Panel (TAP and TEP) for the Information Technology Sector were organized to determine the occupational requirements, curriculum and assessment tests for the Data Encoder, Computer Programmer, Computer Technician and Network Technician;


WHEREAS, education and training in the information technology sector is one of the critical factors in enhancing their competence and skills to meet the manpower requirements in this industry;

WHEREAS, TESDA is responsible for improving the sufficiency and efficiency of this sector through training and education of the middle-level workforce in the information technology industry;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board approves the Training Regulations for the Information Technology Occupations (Computer Programmer, Computer Technician and Network Technician) and for the promulgation of Data Encoder as Skills Standard and not as an Occupational Standard for adoption and implementation to ensure the competitiveness of the workforce.

BE IT RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution and Training Regulations be furnished concerned agencies for their information and implementation and earnestly soliciting their support in the implementation of this training regulation.
