ADOPTING AND IMPLEMENTING THE TRAINING REGULATIONS OF THE GARMENTS AND TEXTILE OCCUPATIONS (TAILOR, DRESSMAKER AND INDUSTRIAL SEWING MACHINE MECHANIC)

WHEREAS, a TESDA Advisory Panel and Experts Panel (TAP and TEP) for the Garments and Textile Sector were organized to determine the occupational requirements, curriculum and assessment tests for the Tailor, Dressmaker and Industrial Sewing machine Mechanic:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board approves the Training Regulations for the Garments and Textile Occupations for adoption and implementation to ensure the competitiveness of the workforce.

BE IT RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution and Training Regulations be furnished concerned agencies for their information and implementation and earnestly soliciting their support in the implementation of this training regulation.
