ADOPTING AND IMPLEMENTING THE TRAINING REGULATIONS
OF THE CONSTRUCTION SECTOR (ROUGH CARPENTER [Level 1]; FINISH CARPENTER
[Level 2 & Level 3], GENERAL MASON, RE-BAR/STEEL FIXER, HEAVY EQUIPMENT
MECHANIC, HYDRAULIC MECHANIC AND CRAWLER CRANE MECHANIC)

WHEREAS, a TESDA Advisory Panel and Experts Panel (TAP and TEP) for the Construction Sector were organized to determine the occupational requirements, curriculum and assessment tests for the (Rough Carpenter [Level 1]; Finish Carpenter [Level 2 & Level 3], General Mason, Re-Bar/Steel Fixer, Heavy Equipment Mechanic, Hydraulic Mechanic and Crawler Crane Mechanic).


WHEREAS, education and training in the Construction Sector is one of the critical factors in enhancing their competence and skills to meet the manpower requirements in this industry;

WHEREAS, TESDA is responsible for improving the sufficiency and efficiency of this sector through training and education of the middle-level workforce in the construction industry;


