APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE TRAINING REGULATIONS FOR THE MARITIME SECTOR (BOATSWAIN [BOSUN], SEAFARER OILER/MOTORMAN AND SEAFARER PUMPMAN)

WHEREAS, the TESDA Advisory Panel (TAP) and TESDA Experts Panel (TEP) for the Maritime Sector were organized to determine the occupational requirements, curriculum and assessment tests for the Boatswain (Bosun), Seafarer-Oiler/Motorman and Seafarer Pumpman;

WHEREAS, education and training in the maritime sector is one of the critical factors in enhancing their competence and skills to meet the manpower requirements in this industry;

WHEREAS, TESDA is responsible for improving the sufficiency and efficiency of this sector through training and education of the middle-level workforce in the maritime industry;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board approves the Training Regulations for the Maritime Sector (Boatswain [Bosun], Seafarer Oiler/Motorman and Seafarer Pumpman) for adoption and implementation to ensure the competitiveness of the workforce;

BE IT RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution and Training Regulations be furnished concerned agencies for their information and participation and earnestly soliciting their support in the implementation of this training regulation.
