RESOLUTION NO. 2000-08

**APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE TRAINING REGULATIONS
FOR THE MARITIME SECTOR (ABLE-BODIED SEAMAN, CHIEF STEWARD,
CHIEF COOK, MASTER FITTER, BOAT CAPTAIN, BOAT ENGINEER, MAJOR PATRON,
MARINE ELECTRICIAN AND MARINE DIESEL ENGINE MECHANIC)**

WHEREAS, the TESDA Advisory Panel (TAP) and TESDA Experts Panel (TEP) for the Maritime Sector were organized to determine the occupational requirements, curriculum and assessment tests for the Able-Bodied Seaman, Chief Steward, Chief Cook, Master Fitter, Boat Captain, Boat Engineer, Major Patron, Marine Electrician and Marine Diesel Engine Mechanic;

WHEREAS, education and training in the maritime sector is one of the critical factors in enhancing their competence and skills to meet the manpower requirements in this industry;

WHEREAS, TESDA is responsible for improving the sufficiency and efficiency of this sector through training and education of the middle-level workforce in the maritime industry;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board approves the Training Regulations for the Maritime Sector (Able-Bodied Seaman, Chief Steward, Chief Cook, Master Fitter, Boat Captain, Boat Engineer, Major Patron, Marine Electrician and Marine Diesel Engine Mechanic) for adoption and implementation to ensure the competitiveness of the workforce;


