#### RESOLUTION NO. 2002 - 01

AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD TO SIGN THE LOAN & PROJECT AGREEMENT, THE ARBITRATION AGREEMENT, THE SEPARATE AGREEMENT AND THE AGENCY CONTRACT FOR THE EXPANSION OF DUAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING (EDET) PROJECT

WHEREAS, Section 8, paragraph 3 of the Republic Act No. 7796, otherwise known as the "Technical Education and Skills Development Act of 1994" grants the TESDA Board power to enter into, make, execute, perform and carry-out domestic and foreign contracts subject to exiting laws, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, in the exercise of this power, the TESDA Board shall approve all contracts, both local and foreign, of the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA);

WHEREAS, during the during the 32<sup>nd</sup> TESDA Board Meeting, 6 July 2001 the TESDA Board approved the Board Resolution No. 2001-01 "Defining the Power of the Chairperson of the TESDA Board and the Director-General of the TESDA Secretariat" to enter into, make and execute domestic and foreign contracts in behalf of the TESDA Board;

WHEREAS, the TESDA Secretariat was able to source and mobilize development funds from the Federal Republic of Germany to expand the adoption of dual education and training in the Philippines through the development of sustainable models in priority sectors identified by the TESDA Board and the strengthening of dual partnership arrangements and schemes;

WHEREAS, this Expansion of Dual Education and Training (EDET) Project entails development funding from the German government through two sources: technical cooperation (grant) through the Deutsche Gesellshaft fur Technische Zusammenarbeit (GTZ) and financial cooperation (loan) through the Kreditanstalt fur Wiederaufbau (KfW):

WHEREAS, the project was approved by the NEDA Board last May 29, 2001 and presented to the TESDA Board - Finance Committee last July 16, 2001 with a project cost of P564.40 million, P126.00 million from grant monies, P289.00 million from loan proceeds and P149.400 million as GOP counterpart;

WHEREAS, negotiations for the grant component of the project were successfully concluded by Philippine & German government representatives in 1999;

WHEREAS, negotiations between KfW and GOP (through the Department of Finance) for the loan component were completed only in November 2001 and, as agreed between KfW and DoF, must be signed before the last working day of December, 2001 to ensure that the loan will be effective by the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2002.

WHEREAS, DoF signed the Loan & Project Agreement as well as the Arbitration Agreement on December 21, 2001 but forwarded the said documents to TESDA only on 3 January 2002

WHEREAS, to enable the conclusion and submission of the said Agreements to KfW, TESDA is being requested by DoF to countersign the above cited Loan & Project Agreement as well as the Arbitration Agreement.

WHEREAS, TESDA, as Project Implementing Agency, is also requested to sign the Separate Agreement and the Agency Contract. The former details the technical aspects of the project as reflected in the NEDA-approved project proposal, while the latter is a formal arrangement for KfW to assist TESDA in selecting and contracting the services of a qualified Consultancy Firm to identify, package, and assist in the procurement, installation and acceptance of training-related equipment for the project beneficiary institutions.

WHEREAS, in recognition of these conditions, the TESDA Board - Finance Committee, represented by its Chairperson, after studying the matter, favorably endorsed to the members of the TESDA Board, the authorization for the Chair of the TESDA Board to sign the said Agreements in behalf of the organization.

BE IT RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this resolution and Agreements be furnished to concerned parties for their information and implementation and earnestly soliciting their support ion the implementation of the Project.

Attached, please find communication from the Director-General requesting the Board's instructions on who would sign the Loan & Project Agreement, the Arbitration Agreement, the Separate Agreement and the Agency Contract for the above cited project on behalf of TESDA.

This representation was done in consideration of the following:

- the project entails development funding from the German government through two sources: technical cooperation (grant) through the Deutsche Gesellshaft fur Technische Zusammenarbeit (GTZ) and financial cooperation (loan) through the Kreditanstalt fur Wiederaufbau (KfW)
- the project was approved by the NEDA Board last May 29, 2001 and presented to the TESDA Board - Finance Committee last July 16, 2001
- the project costs P564.400 million with P126.000 million coming from grant monies, P289.000 million from loan proceeds and P149.400 million as GOP counterpart
- negotiations for the grant component of the project were successfully concluded by representatives of the Philippine and German governments as early as 1999
- while a separate/updated agreement based on the NEDA Board approval was not required for the bulk of the grant component of the project, the sub-grant of approximately P16.000 million pesos specifically for the SZOPAD area required a separate Financing Agreement. Authorization to sign this Agreement covering the TESDA-GTZ SZOPAD sub-project was granted to the Director-General by the TESDA Board on September 6, 2001



- negotiations between KfW and GOP (through the Department of Finance) for the loan component of approximately P289.000 million were completed only in November 2001 and, as agreed between KfW and DoF, must be signed before the last working day of December, 2001 to ensure that the loan will be effective by the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2002.
- DoF signed the Loan & Project Agreement as well as the Arbitration Agreement on December 21, 2001 but forwarded the said documents to TESDA only on 3 January 2002
- to enable the conclusion and submission of the said Agreements to KfW, TESDA is being requested by DoF to countersign the above cited Loan & Project Agreement, as well as the Arbitration Agreement. Upon TESDA's request DOF is in the process of securing authority to sign for TESDA
- TESDA, as Project Implementing Agency, is also requested to sign the Separate Agreement and the Agency Contract. The former details the technical aspects of the project as reflected in the NEDA-approved project proposal, while the latter is a formal arrangement for KfW to assist TESDA in selecting and contracting the services of an independent, qualified Consultancy Firm, domiciled in the Federal Republic of Germany and awarded on the basis of competitive bidding to identify, package, and assist in the procurement, installation and acceptance of training-related equipment for the project beneficiary institutions.

In this regard, and in consideration of the reduced credibility should the Agreements not be concluded by the agreed deadline, I am endorsing before the members of the TESDA Board for your approval, through a referendum, the attached pre-dated Board Resolution No. 2001 - 0/ Authorizing the Chairman of the TESDA Board to sign the Loan & Project Agreement, the Arbitration Agreement, the Separate Agreement and the Agency Contract for the Expansion of Dual Education and Training Project.
