DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY IN FAVOR OF THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE TESDA SECRETARIAT TO EXTEND THE SERVICE CONTRACT OF CHEVRON SECURITY AND INVESTIGATION SERVICES AND SUPER CLEAN JANITORIAL SERVICES IN BEHALF OF THE TESDA BOARD ON A MONTHLY BASIS UNDER THE PRINCIPLE OF QUANTUM MERUIT

WHEREAS, section 8, paragraph 3 of Republic Act No. 7796, otherwise known as the "Technical Education and Skills Development Act of 1994", grants the TESDA Board the power to enter into, make, execute, perform and carry-out domestic and foreign contracts, subject to existing law, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, in the exercise of this power, the TESDA Board shall approve all contracts, both local and foreign, of the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA);

WHEREAS, the TESDA BOARD, in recognition of services rendered by Super Clean Janitorial Services and Chevron Security and Investigation Services, despite expiration of their service contracts and upon motion of the Deputy Director General Alcestis M. Guiang, premised on the recommendation of the Chairman, PBAC, that their resolution and recommendation on the Public Bidding conducted last December 17, 2003, shall still be submitted for the approval of the Board, the TESDA Board hereby authorize the Director General to extend the service contracts of the above-mentioned Service Providers, on a month to month basis, and shall call for its termination upon the signing of the contracts with the awarded service providers;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers vested upon them by law, on motion of DDG Alcestis M. Guiang, with concurrence of the TESDA Board Resource Generation, Allocation and Utilization Committee, the TESDA Board HEREBY RESOLVES, as it RESOLVED, to authorize the Director General to extend the Service Contract of CHEVRON Security and Investigation Services and Super Clean Services Corporation Janitorial Services on a monthly basis in observance with the principle of Quantum Meruit, provided that such extension shall not exceed March 31, 2003;

# uantum Meruit

QUANTUM MERUIT - As much as he has deserved. When a person employs another to do work for him, without any agreement as to his compensation, the law implies a promise from, the employer to the workman that he will pay him for his services, as much as be may deserve or merit. In such case the plaintiff may suggest in his declaration that the defendant promised to pay him as much as he reasonably deserved, and then aver that his trouble was worth sucli a sum of money, which the defendant has omitted to pay. This is called an assumpsit on a quantum

When there is an express contract for a stipulated amount and mode of compensation for services, the plaintiff cannot abandon the contract and resort to an action for a quantum meruit --b--

The Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) and its Secretariat are now completing the final evaluation of the bid proposals both for the security and janitorial services requirements of TESDA Central Office. To date, we have already reviewed and consolidated the information gathered from the documents submitted to us. Lately, we asked for additional information/documents from our bidders to further evaluate and establish their capabilities. From there, we shall decide the manner or extent of the background investigation for the qualifying

To expedite the process, the members of the BAC have agreed to conclude all required courses of action and other concerns for this bidding on or before 31 January 2003. At once, we shall submit the BAC Resolution to your office on or before February 4, 2003 for your review

Since the total value of these service contracts requires the review and concurrence of the TESDA Board, there are administrative procedures that must be observed. Under the IRR of E.O. 40, we need at least 32 calendar days to complete the processes. As such, the Notice to Proceed to our winning bidder may only be issued on March 2003. (Please see attached matrix of activities on this bidding).

Considering all the factors/conditions required in the conduct of such bidding, the Authority may have recourse but to **maintain/extend the services** of our current security and janitorial service providers until such time that the contract of the (new) winning bidder has been awarded and duly approved.
