RESOLUTION NO. 2003 - 10

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY IN FAVOR OF THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE TESDA SECRETARIAT TO EXTEND THE SERVICE CONTRACTS OF CHEVRON SECURITY AND INVESTIGATION SERVICES AND SUPER CLEAN JANITORIAL SERVICES IN BEHALF OF THE TESDA BOARD FOR AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF ONE (1) MONTH OR UNTIL APRIL 30, 2003.

WHEREAS, section 8, paragraph 3 of Republic Act No. 7796, otherwise known as the "Technical Education and Skills Development Act of 1994", grants the TESDA Board the power to enter into, make, execute, perform and carry-out domestic and foreign contracts, subject to existing law, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, in the exercise of this power, the TESDA Board shall approve all contracts, both local and foreign, of the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA);

WHEREAS, the TESDA BOARD, in recognition of services rendered by Superclean Services Corporation and Chevron Security and Investigation Services, despite expiration of their service contracts had given the Director General the authority to extend their respective service contract on a month to month basis, until March 31, 2003;

WHEREAS, the Director General submitted the BAC recommendation on the results of the Public Bidding and after review by the RGAU Committee, taking into consideration the comments from the members of the Committee, Director General Alcestis M. Guiang, approved and adopted the recommendation to award the Contract of Security Services in favor of ENVISAGE SECURITY AGENCY INCORPORATED and set aside the recommendation of the BAC to award the Janitorial Services Contract in favor of Superclean Janitorial Services, and in its stead recommended to award the Contract for Janitorial Services in favor of GOODLINE STAFFERS AND ALLIED SERVICES, INC., due to its lower bid by Four Hundred Thousand Pesos (P400,000.00);

WHEREAS, upon motion of Director General Alcestis M. Guiang, in order to allow the winning service provider bidders to mobilize and assume its duties and responsibilities in agreement with the current Security and Janitorial Service Providers, the TESDA Board hereby authorizes the Director General to extend the service contracts of the CHEVRON Security and Investigation Services and Superclean Services Corporation under the same terms and conditions of their

respective original contract for an additional period of one month or until April 30, 2003;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers vested upon them by law, on motion of DG Alcestis M. Guiang, with the recommendation of the TESDA Resource Generation, Allocation and Utilization Committee, the TESDA Board HEREBY RESOLVES, as it RESOLVED, to authorize the Director General to extend the Service Contracts of CHEVRON Security and Investigation Services and Superclean Services Corporation for an additional period of one (1) month or until April 30, 2003.
