WHEREAS, Section 19 of Republic Act. No. 7796, otherwise known as the TESDA Act of 1994, provides for the establishment of Technical Education and Skills Development Committees at the regional and local levels to coordinate and monitor the delivery of all skills development activities by the public and private sectors;

WHEREAS, the Technical Education and Skills Development Committees (TESDCs) were organized in May 1996 through TESDA Board Resolution No. 96-01, Approving and Promulgating the Rules and Regulations on the Organization of Technical Education and Skills Development (TESD) Committees;

WHEREAS, on December 19, 2000, the 5th Philippine TVET Forum, participated in by the TESDA Board and TESDC members convened, to specifically focus on redefining and rationalizing the roles, processes and structures of the Committees and on strengthening the TESDCs as the major arm in the governance and management of the TVET sector at the local levels.

Strengthening TESDA Board – TESDC Relationship: Designation of Regional TESDA Board Focal Person from among the TESDA Board Members

I. Rationale

The Technical Education and Skills Development Committees (TESDCs) were organized in May 1996, through TESDA Board (TB) Resolution No. 96-01, approving the Rules and Regulations on the Organization of the TESDCs. This is consistent with Section 19 of the TESDA Act of 1994 which states that "the Authority shall establish the Technical Education and Skills Development Committees at the regional and local levels to coordinate and monitor the delivery of all skills development activities by the public and private sectors".

Over the years, the TESDCs have evolved to be an important mechanism for the deliberation of and resolving critical TVET issues at the local levels. At present, the TESDCs act as the subsidiary of the TESDA Board (TB) at the regional and provincial levels. There is much to be desired, however, in terms of the direct relationship and communication between the TB and the TESDCs and to ensure that the issues raised by the TESDCs are elevated and discussed at the TB.

It is in recognition of the need to establish a more direct interaction and relationship between the TB and the TESDCs that the designation of a regional TB focal person from among the TB was conceived.

II. Objective

General

To strengthen the collaborative relationship between and among the TB, the TESDCs and the TESDA Secretariat

Specific

- To ensure that the relevant policy issues raised by the R/PTESDCs for TB action are deliberated and acted upon accordingly;
- 2. To have a specific TB member supporting and shepherding the R/PTESDCs of a particular region;

3. To enhance the policy formulation process for TVET particularly in the discussions/consultations of the annual policy agenda approved by the TB; and

4. To strengthen the monitoring of the status of policy implementation,

particularly the policies formulated by the TB.

III. Mechanics/Process

Regional TESDC Forum

A regional TESDC Forum participated in by R/PTESDC members shall be convened prior to the visitation of the regional TB focal person. This meeting shall serve as a venue to discuss policy issues and concerns that shall be raised to the TB and other issues affecting and related to TESDCs. This shall document the various TESDC issues and concerns to serve as inputs to the consultation meeting with the regional TB focal person.

Regional Visit of the TB Focal Person

The regional consultation meeting of the TB focal person and the TESDC in the regions shall be at least once a year. The Regional TESDC and the PTESDC Chairs shall attend the meetings. The TESDC Secretariat shall facilitate the administrative arrangements and technical requirements for the meeting.

The agenda of the consultation meeting shall be prepared by the Regional Secretariat and shall include a brief report of the region and its provinces, a discussion of a policy agenda which will have weight on the RO, relevant policy issues and concerns of the R/PTESDC among others.

TESDA Board - RTESDC Chair Forum

An annual Forum to be participated in by the TESDA Board and the RTESDC Chairs shall be conducted every 3rd quarter of the year.

IV. Roles of the TESDA Board Focal Person

- Act as a channel for communication of the concerned TESDCs in the TESDA Board;
- 2. Review and assess the activities of the TESDCs as well as their inputs to the annual policy agenda; and
- Conduct periodic visits / consultations and attend TESDC meetings to provide directioning to the TESDCs.

V. TESDA Board Regional Assignments

Each region shall have one designated regional TB focal person. Other members may opt to join the regional TB focal person. The Director General or any of the three (3) Deputy Directors General shall join the focal person to answer secretariat concerns. If they are not available, senior officials can be assigned as alternates.

shall consolidate issues submitted by the Regional TESDCs for

submission to the TB; and

shall provide all TB Members with the documentation of RO/PO activities for action and comments.

Regional/Provincial Office

shall coordinate schedules and activities of the TB member in the region and provinces;

shall document all activities and submit it to the Planning Office

for consolidation; and

shall also be responsible for the administrative arrangements such as accommodation, transportation of the TB member's stay in the region/province.

VII. Travelling Expenses

The travelling expenses of the TESDA Board members shall be charged against the budget of the TESDA Board.
