Approving and Adopting the Fifty Percent (50%) Discount on the Non-Refundable TVET Program Registration Fee of Two Thousand Pesos (Php2,000.00) for State Universities and Colleges' (SUCs) Courses under the Unified TVET Program Registration and Accreditation System (UTPRAS)

WHEREAS. Republic Act No. 7796 otherwise known as TESDA Act of 1994 empowers TESDA to establish and maintain a system of accrediting, coordinating, integrating, monitoring and evaluating formal and non-formal technical vocational education and training programs:

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7796 defines Technical Education as the education process designed at post secondary and lower tertiary levels, officially recognized as non-degree programs aimed at preparing technicians, para-professionals and other categories of middle-level workers by providing them with a broad range of general education, theoretical, scientific and technological studies, and related job skills training;

WHEREAS, Board Resolution No. 98-03 Establishes a Unified TVET Program Registration and Accreditation System;

WHEREAS, Board Resolution No. 2000-03 Approves the Adoption of the Omnibus Amendatory Guidelines in the Establishment of the Unified TVET Program Registration and Accreditation System identifying the coverage of UTPRAS to include all TVET programs offered by public and private institutions, including programs offered by enterprise—based training centers, provided that programs that are offered in the latter are fee charging and open to the public; all TVET programs in industrial trades and crafts, agriculture, fishery, services and home industries, among others are covered by the system. TVET programs with permit and recognition certificates granted by the Secretary of the Department of Education which shall be reviewed and registered under UTPRAS within the prescribed period, and including a module of employable competency or a set of modules which may be registered as a TVET program under UTPRAS;

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WHEREAS, Board Resolution No. 2003-17 Approves and Adopts the Unified TVET Program Registration System (UTPRAS) Guidelines on Sanctions and Penalties;

WHEREAS, the TESDA Board Members during its 49th TESDA Board.Meeting, 20 April 2006 agreed and approved the fifty percent (50%) discount on the non-refundable TVET Program Registration Fee of two thousand pesos (Php2,000.00) or equivalent discounted non-refundable TVET Program Registration Fee of one thousand pesos (Php1,000.00) for State Universities and Colleges' (SUCs) programs;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS approves the fifty percent (50%) discount on the non-refundable TVET Program Registration Fee for State Universities and Colleges' (SUCs) programs;

BE IT RESOLVED FINALLY, that the Board directs the Secretariat to disseminate the resolution to all concerned.
