APPROVING AND PROMULGATING THE TRAINING REGULATIONS FOR SANITARY LANDFILL OPERATIONS NC II

WHEREAS, Section 14 (b) of Republic Act No. 7796 mandates that TESDA shall develop and establish a national system of skills standardization, testing and certification and conduct research and development on various occupational areas in order to recommend policies, rules and regulations for effective and efficient skills standardization, testing and certification system in the country.

WHEREAS, concerns relating to environmental protection and sustainability has led to more emphasis in the area of solid-waste management;

WHEREAS, the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 Republic Act No. 9003) calls for, among others, skills development along the various areas relating to operation and maintenance of sanitary landfills for municipal/city waste, particularly managing in-coming wastes for active landfill cells and maintaining closed landfills;

WHEREAS, in the 15th Direction Setting (DS) Committee TESDA Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting on 11 December 2012, the TESDA Board approved the prioritization for training regulations development of qualification along solid-waste management which includes the job of Spotter;

WHEREAS, industry experts and partners, headed by Ms. Lizette C. Cardenas of the Solid Waste Management Association of the Philippines (SWAPP), Mr. Crispian N. Liao of the National Solid Waste Management Commission (NSWMC-DENR), Ms. Isabelita P. Mercado of the Solid Waste Contractors' Association of the Philippines (SWACAP) and other organizations involved in sanitary landfill operations with the assistance of the Qualifications and Standards Office (QSO) of TESDA, have developed and endorsed the same for TESDA Board approval;

WHEREAS, during the 81st Special Standards-Setting and Systems Development (SSSD) Committee TESDA Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting held on 11 November 2015, the Committee favorably endorsed the promulgation of the above-mentioned Training Regulations for Sanitary Landfill Operations NC II;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED,, that the TESDA Board in its meeting today, 16 December 2015 at 2:00 p.m. approves and promulgates the aforementioned Training Regulations for Sanitary Landfill Operations NC II, as herein appended;

BE IT RESOLVED, FINALLY, that (1) copies of this Resolution and the abovementioned Training Regulations be published and disseminated to all concerned, and the same shall be effective fifteen (15) days upon publication;

- (2) All programs to be registered under these new Training Regulations must comply with the requirements of the aforementioned Training Regulations. The one-year period of registration under this new Training Regulations shall commence on the date of effectivity as indicated in the Implementing Guidelines/ TESDA Circular for the deployment of the Training Regulations to be issued by the TESDA Secretariat; and
- (3) Graduates of TVET programs covered by the aforementioned Training Regulations shall be required to undergo mandatory assessment under the national assessment and certification program.
