**APPROVING AND PROMULGATING THE TRAINING REGULATIONS FOR  
WAREHOUSING SERVICES NC II**

**WHEREAS**, Section 14 (b) of Republic Act No. 7796 mandates that TESDA shall develop and establish a national system of skills standardization, testing and certification and conduct research and development on various occupational areas in order to recommend policies, rules and regulations for effective and efficient skills standardization, testing and certification system in the country.

**WHEREAS**, concerns relating to transport and logistics has led to more emphasis in the area of warehousing services;

**WHEREAS**, the APEC transport and logistics qualification benchmarking project calls for, among others, skills development in the following areas; warehousing operator, logistics administrative officer, warehouse supervisor, freight forwarder and supply chain manager and with the objective of improving linkages between industry and vocational education and training programs and improving recognition arrangements across economies;

**WHEREAS**, in the Special Direction Setting Committee TESDA Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting held last 16 November 2015, the body approved the prioritization for training regulations development of qualifications along transport and logistics, which includes warehousing services;

**WHEREAS**, industry experts and partners, headed by Mrs. Corazon C. Curay, President of Supply Chain Management Association of the Philippines. (SCMAP) and other organizations involved in transport and logistics with the technical assistance of the Qualifications and Standards Office (QSO) of TESDA have developed and endorsed the same for TESDA Board approval;

**WHEREAS**, during the 78<sup>th</sup>, 79<sup>th</sup> and Special Standards-Setting and Systems Development (SSSD) Committee –TESDA Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meetings held on 02 July 2015, 18 September 2015 and 30 October 2015 respectively, the Committee favorably endorsed the promulgation of the above-mentioned Training Regulations for Warehousing Services NC II;

**APPROVING AND PROMULGATING THE TRAINING REGULATIONS FOR  
WAREHOUSING SERVICES NC II**

**WHEREAS**, during the 92<sup>nd</sup> TESDA Board Meeting on 16 December 2015 at 2:00 p.m., the TESDA Board considered and approved the promulgation of the Training Regulations for Warehousing Services NC II;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, that the TESDA Board in this meeting today, 16 December 2015 at 2:00 p.m. approves and promulgates the aforementioned Training Regulations for Warehousing Services NC II, as herein appended;

**BE IT RESOLVED, FINALLY**, that (1) copies of this Resolution and the abovementioned Training Regulations be published and disseminated to all concerned, and the same shall be effective fifteen (15) days upon publication;


(2) All programs to be registered under these new Training Regulations must comply with the requirements of the aforementioned Training Regulations. The one-year period of registration under this new Training Regulations shall commence on the date of effectivity of the Implementing Guidelines/ TESDA Circular for the deployment of the Training Regulations to be issued by the TESDA Secretariat; and

(3) Graduates of TVET programs covered by the aforementioned Training Regulations shall be required to undergo mandatory assessment under the national assessment and certification program.
