WHEREAS, the Philippine Bamboo Foundation, Inc. (PBFI) as one of the industry stakeholders supported the prioritization of Bamboo Processing during the Sectoral Industry Consultation held on February 26-27, 2015;

WHEREAS, TESDA Board Resolution No. 2015-15 indicated that Bamboo Processing is one of the prioritized qualifications;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Bamboo Foundation referred Cabaluyan 2nd Bamboo Manufacturers and Growers Association is the lead industry organization in the Agriculture, Forestry and Fishery Sector and known provider of the expertise needed for the industry;

WHEREAS, the Cabaluyan 2nd Bamboo Manufacturers and Growers Association in partnership with Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) with the assistance of Qualifications and Standards Office (QSO) of TESDA has developed the Training Regulations in Bamboo Processing (Engineered Bamboo) NC II for Agriculture, Forestry and Fishery (AFF) Sector;

WHEREAS, the Cabaluyan 2nd Bamboo Manufacturers and Growers Association initiated the development of the Training Regulations (TRs) for Bamboo Processing (Engineered Bamboo) NC II with the assistance of Qualifications and Standards Office (QSO);

WHEREAS, the scope of work of the new TRs for Bamboo Processing (Engineered Bamboo) NC II involves to perform basic bamboo processing, carry-out treatment of semi-processed bamboo materials, perform kiln drying, perform milling
