WHEREAS, during the 110<sup>th</sup> TESDA Board Meeting, a suggestion was made to recommend the inclusion of the Professional Regulatory Commission (PRC) in the TESDA Board as one of the government sector representatives to simplify the implementation of the Philippine Qualifications Framework, which aims to elevate the Training Regulations to a level of sub-professional;

WHEREAS, Legal Division of TESDA finds the inclusion of PRC as a member of the TESDA Board as a reassuring change for the further professionalization of TESDA courses;

WHEREAS, during the 3<sup>rd</sup> Ad Hoc Committee on Legal Matters Meeting, an agreement to seek the consent of the PRC with the proposal to include them in the TESDA Board was made;

WHEREAS, in a Letter dated 27 May 2019, the Director General of TESDA sought the concurrence of the PRC Chairman to the proposal to be part of the TESDA Board as one of the representatives of the TESDA Board;

WHEREAS, in a Letter dated 10 July 2019, PRC Chairman Teofilo S. Pilando, Jr. manifested the concurrence of the Professional Regulatory Commission of such proposal, as it would enhance collaboration and cooperation inasmuch as both agencies share many areas where their respective mandates could be supportive of each other;

WHEREAS, during the 1st Joint Meeting of the SSSDC and Ad-Hoc Committee on Legal Matters, it was initially recommended to include PRC as a Non-Voting Member of the TESDA Board;

WHEREAS, Atty. Lovelika T. Bautista, OIC Director, Legal Service of the Professional Regulatory Commission (PRC) attended the meeting, and suggested that instead of including PRC as a Non-Voting Member of the TESDA Board, the TESDA may instead enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the PRC;
