- 1. Priority needs of the industry-sector;
- 2. Nationwide application in terms of public interest/welfare:
- 3. Employment generation and investment opportunities; and
- 4. The criteria for skills standardization and certification, to wit:
 - Requiring relatively long period of education or training;
 - Performance of the competency affecting and endangering people's lives and limbs; and
 - Competency involving the handling of complex equipment, tools and supplies.

WHEREAS, in addition to the abovementioned criteria, support for the development of skills/qualifications shall also be prioritized based on the government's thrust for the continued provision of needed qualitative and quantitative measures to effectively and efficiently monitor the implementation and achievements of priority government programs and projects;

WHEREAS, the Data Collection qualification has been proposed as a Priority qualification as presented by the Philippine Statistics Authority, and supported by the data/information from public and private sector research and survey institutions during the 33rd Direction Setting Committee TESDA Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting held last 22 November 2019;

WHEREAS, during the abovementioned meeting, the Data Collection qualification was recommended to be elevated to the TESDA Board for prioritization for TR development, with the condition that the following data are provided;
