**APPROVING AND PROMULGATING THE TRAINING REGULATIONS FOR
HANDLOOM WEAVING (UPRIGHT) NC II**

WHEREAS, Section 14 (b) of Republic Act No. 7796 mandates that TESDA shall develop and establish a national system of skills standardization, testing and certification and conduct research and development on various occupational areas in order to recommend policies, rules and regulations for effective and efficient skills standardization, testing and certification system in the country;

WHEREAS, the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) - Philippine Textile Research Institute (PTRI) and National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) are the lead industry organizations in Handloom Weaving under the Creative Sector and known providers of the expertise needed for the industry;

WHEREAS, the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) - Philippine Textile Research Institute (PTRI) and National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) initiated the development of the Training Regulations (TR) for Handloom Weaving (Upright) NC II with the assistance of Qualifications and Standards Office (QSO);

WHEREAS, the scope of the work of the new TR for Handloom Weaving NC II involves in the preparatory activities prior to weaving on a loom; perform basic handloom operations; recognize and check product quality; complete the whole weaving process including finishing and final quality assessment and able to market and promote the finished woven product;

WHEREAS, industry experts and partners, headed by the Director of Department of Science and Technology (DOST) - Philippine Textile Research Institute (PTRI) and technical expert from National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), with the technical assistance of the Qualifications and Standards Office (QSO) of TESDA have developed and endorsed the same for TESDA Board Approval;

WHEREAS, during the 117th Standards-Setting and Systems Development (SSSD) Committee Meeting held on 04 February 2020, the Committee deliberated

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upon and favorably recommended to the TESDA Board the promulgation of the Training Regulations for Handloom Weaving (Upright) NC II;

WHEREAS, during the 119th TESDA Board Meeting on 18 February 2020 at 9:00 a.m., the TESDA Board considered and approved the promulgation of the Training Regulations for Handloom Weaving (Upright) NC II;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the TESDA Board in its meeting today, 18 February 2020 at 9:00 a.m., approves and promulgates the aforementioned Training Regulations for Handloom Weaving (Upright) NC II as herein appended;

BE IT RESOLVED, FINALLY, that:

(1) Copies of this Resolution and the abovementioned Training Regulations be published in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation, and disseminated to all concerned, and the same shall be effective fifteen (15) days upon publication;

(2) All programs to be registered under this new Training Regulations must comply with the requirements of the aforementioned Training Regulations. The registration under this new Training Regulations shall commence on the date of effectivity as indicated in the Implementing Guidelines/ TESDA Circular for the deployment of the Training Regulations to be issued by the TESDA Secretariat; and

(3) Graduates of TVET programs covered by the aforementioned Training Regulations shall be required to undergo mandatory assessment under the national assessment and certification program.

(4) Copy of the Training Regulations is hereby made an integral part of this Resolution.

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
