APPROVING AND PROMULGATING THE TRAINING REGULATIONS FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES NC III

WHEREAS, Section 14 (b) of Republic Act No. 7796 mandates that TESDA shall develop and establish a national system of skills standardization, testing and certification and conduct research and development on various occupational areas in order to recommend policies, rules and regulations for effective and efficient skills standardization, testing and certification system in the country;

WHEREAS, the Department of Health (DOH) as the lead national government agency under the Human Health/Health Care Sector is known to be a provider of the expertise needed for the industry;

WHEREAS, the Health Emergency Management Bureau (HEMB) - Department of Health (DOH) together with the Philippine International Emergency Medical Services Registry (PIEMSR), Ecumenical Christian College (ECC) in Tarlac City, Philippine College of Emergency Medicine (PCEM), Philippine Red Cross (PRC) and Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP-National Headquarters) initiated the development of the Training Regulations (TR) for Emergency Medical Services NC III with the assistance of the Qualifications and Standards Office (QSO);

WHEREAS, the scope of the work of the new TR for Emergency Medical Services NC III prepares the emergency medical technician to provide prehospital assessment and care for patients of all ages with a variety of medical conditions and traumatic injuries;

WHEREAS, the industry experts and partners, headed by the Bureau Director of the Health Emergency Management Bureau (HEMB) - Department of Health (DOH), with the technical assistance of the Qualifications and Standards Office (QSO) of TESDA have developed the Training Regulations for Emergency Medical Services NC III and endorsed the same for the approval by the TESDA Board;

WHEREAS, during the 127th Standards-Setting and Systems Development (SSSD) Committee Meeting held on 10 September 2020, the Committee deliberated upon and favorably recommended to the TESDA Board the promulgation of the Training Regulations for Emergency Medical Services NC III;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the aforementioned Training Regulations for Emergency Medical Services NC III as herein appended are hereby approved and promulgated;

BE IT RESOLVED, FINALLY, that:

- (1) Copies of this Resolution and the abovementioned Training Regulations be published in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation, and disseminated to all concerned, and the same shall be effective fifteen (15) days upon publication;
- (2) All programs to be registered under this new Training Regulations must comply with the requirements of the aforementioned Training Regulations. The registration under this new Training Regulations shall commence on the date of effectivity as indicated in the Implementing Guidelines/ TESDA Circular for the deployment of the Training Regulations to be issued by the TESDA Secretariat; and
- (3) Graduates of TVET programs covered by the aforementioned Training Regulations shall be required to undergo mandatory assessment under the national assessment and certification program.
