WHEREAS, the Director General issued TESDA Circular No. 065 series of 2021 dated July 16, 2021 with the subject "Guidelines in the Conduct of the Philippine National Skills Competition (PNSC);

WHEREAS, Sec. 27 of Republic Act No. 7796, also provides that the Authority shall develop and administer appropriate incentive schemes to encourage government and private industries and institutions to provide high-quality technical education and skills development opportunities;

WHEREAS, to efficiently and effectively promote skills development in the country and to encourage competitors to participate in international skills competition, it is necessary to give some form of financial incentives to winners of various skills competitions and to also recognize the efforts of the experts who have trained them;

WHEREAS, such recognition and financial incentive will also encourage both public and private TVIs and TVET graduates/students to further hone their skills and represent the country on the international skills competitions;
