APPROVING THE NATIONAL TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PLAN (NTESDP) 2023-2028

WHEREAS, Section 21 of Republic Act No. 7796 and Rule II Section 1 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations states that "The Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) shall formulate a comprehensive development plan for middle-level manpower based on a national employment plan or policies for the optimum allocation, development and utilization of skilled workers for employment, entrepreneurship and technology development for economic and social growth, to be known as the National Technical Education and Skills Development Plan (NTESDP)";

WHEREAS, Section 8 (1) of the TESDA Law mandates the TESDA Board to promulgate, after due consultation with industry associations, employers, workers, policies, plans, programs and guidelines, as maybe necessary, for the efficient implementation of the Act;

WHEREAS, Section 8 of Republic Act No. 7796 states that the Authority shall primarily be responsible for monitoring and coordinating the implementation of the national technical education and skills development plan and allocate resources necessary to achieve its goals and targets;

WHEREAS, pursuant to President Marcos' "8-Point Socio-Economic Agenda" and anchored on the national goals and priorities enunciated in the Philippine Development Plan (PDP) 2023-2028 and the "AmBisyon Natin 2040", TESDA led the formulation of the National Technical Education and Skills Development Plan (NTESDP) 2023-2028;

WHEREAS, the Fifth Cycle NTESDP 2023-2028 builds on the successes of the previous NTESDPs and highlights the envisioned contributions of technical vocational education and training (TVET) towards ensuring transformative lifelong learning opportunities for all and increasing their income-earning ability;

WHEREAS, the NTESDP 2023-2028 envisions a "Globally Recognized Philippine TVET as a Catalyst for Education and Lifelong Learning. Workforce. and Socio-Economic Transformation" and discusses the TVET's contribution relative to the whole education and training system and its critical role in the overall national development process;

WHEREAS, the NTESDP considered the inputs of the different stakeholders, such as the Regional/Provincial Technical Education and Skills Development Committees (R/PTESDCs),

government through the NTESDP Inter-Agency Committee, industry, academe, labor, NGOs, TVET clients, and other sectors through the conduct of national and regional consultations and workshops.

WHEREAS, the NTESDP was also presented to the NEDA Social Development Committee (SDC) Technical Board Meeting last July 13, 2023 and the NEDA SDC Cabinet-Level last July 27, pending approval upon presentation of the Plan to the TESDA Board;

WHEREAS, during the 141st TESDA Board Meeting held on August 16, 2023 at the TESDA Board Room, 7th Floor TESDA Main Building, the aforementioned NTESDP 2023-2028 plan document was deliberated and favorably endorsed for approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the TESDA Board in its meeting on August 16, 2023 at the TESDA Board Room, 7th Floor TESDA Main Building, approves the National Technical Education and Skills Development Plan (NTESDP) 2023-2028;

BE IT RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this resolution be published and disseminated to all concerned.
