RESOLUTION NO. 15-2016

RECOMMENDING THE APPROVAL OF THE AWARD OF CONTRACTS TO ACMI OFFICE SYSTEMS PHILIPPINES, INC. FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF STARTER TOOLKITS FOR THE SPECIAL TRAINING FOR EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM (STEP) FY 2016 – PHASE II ON A PER LOT BASIS AND DECLARING A FAILURE OF BIDDING ON LOT 34 (PERFORM HAND SPA [LEADING TO BEAUTY CARE NC II])

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), as mandated by Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, is the body tasked to post invitations to bid, to conduct pre-bid conferences, to determine the eligibility of prospective bidders, to receive and open bids, to conduct the evaluation of bids, to conduct post-qualification and to recommend award of contracts to the Head of the Procuring Entity;

WHEREAS, in view of the procurement of starter toolkits for the Special Training for Employment Program (STEP) for FY 2016 – Phase II, the Director General created a Technical Working Group (TWG) that will identify the requirements for the implementation of STEP which shall necessarily include the identification of the qualifications and corresponding tools and equipment that will be covered by STEP. The TWG came out with the list of qualifications with corresponding tools and equipment in close coordination with the TESDA Regional Offices. A copy of TESDA Order No. 16, Series of 2016, issued on 21 January 2016 is hereto attached as Annex "A";

WHEREAS, the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) intends to apply the sum of One Hundred Twenty-Seven Million Six Hundred Fifty-Eight Thousand Seventy Pesos and Eighty-Six Centavos Only (Php127,658,070.86) being the total Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for the procurement of starter toolkits for the Special Training for Employment Program (STEP) for FY 2016 – Phase II. Copies of the Terms of Reference (TOR) and Obligation Request (OBR) duly approved by the Director General are hereto attached as Annexes "B" and "C", respectively;

WHEREAS, the BAC upon receipt of the TOR for the procurement of starter toolkits for the Special Training for Employment Program (STEP) for FY 2016 – Phase II convened on 06 May 2016 at 3:15 p.m. at the CSA Conference Room located at 2nd Floor of TESDA Administration Building in Taguig City to conduct a

pre-procurement conference with the end-user's representative in accordance with Section 20 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184. A copy of the Minutes of the Meeting is hereto attached as Annex "D";

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 21 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, TESDA advertised on 10 May 2016 the Invitation to Bid for the procurement of starter toolkits for the Special Training for Employment Program (STEP) for FY 2016 – Phase II in a newspaper of general circulation and posted the same in the PhilGEPS on 10 May 2016. Copies of which are hereto attached as Annexes "E" and "F", respectively;

WHEREAS, responding to the abovementioned Invitation to Bid, only ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated signified its interest to participate in said bidding process by purchasing bidding documents. A copy of the official receipt for the purchase of bidding documents is hereto attached as Annex "G";

WHEREAS, the BAC in compliance also with the directive of the Director General invited several observers registered with PhilGEPS to witness the bidding activities particularly on the procurement of starter toolkits for the Special Training for Employment Program (STEP) for FY 2016 – Phase II for purposes of transparency and good governance. Pursuant to Section 13 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, the BAC invited several observers to attend the pre-bid conference on 19 May 2016 and the bid opening on 03 June 2016. Copies of the letters to observers are hereto attached as Annexes "H" "I", "J", "K", "L", "M" and "N", respectively;

WHEREAS, the pre-bid conference was held on 19 May 2016 at 2:10 p.m. at the CSA Conference Room located at 2nd Floor of TESDA Administration Building in Taguig City. A copy of the Minutes of the Meeting is hereto attached as Annex "O";

WHEREAS, the issues and concerns of the bidder present during the pre-bid conference had been addressed to by the BAC through the issuance of Bid Bulletin No. 01 dated 19 May 2016. Copy of the bid bulletin is hereto attached as Annex "P";

WHEREAS, accordingly, a Technical Evaluation Group (TEG) was created to assist the BAC in evaluating the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted by ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated during the bid opening. A copy of the BAC Order No. 07, Series of 2016, issued on 19 May 2016 is hereto attached as Annex "Q";

WHEREAS, the bid opening was held on 03 June 2016 at 2:05 p.m. at the CSA Conference Room located at 2nd Floor of TESDA Administration Building in Taguig City. A copy of the Minutes of the Meeting is hereto attached as Annex "R";

WHEREAS, during the bid opening, ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated failed to comply with the requirement relative to the computation of the Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC). The bidder committed an error in reflecting that its current assets is Two Hundred Thirty Four Million Two Hundred Sixty Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety Nine Pesos and 33/100 (Php234,268,899.33). When in fact, according to its Audited Financial Statement

(AFS) for 2015, its current assets is Two Hundred Thirty Four Million Two Hundred Sixty Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Nine Pesos and 33/100 (Php234,268,889.33) leaving a difference of One Hundred Pesos (Php100.00);

WHEREAS, ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated was held ineligible to bid for its failure to submit the correct computation of its Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) pursuant to Section 23.5.2.6 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184. The second envelope containing the financial component of the bid of ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated was not opened. Copies of the Eligibility Requirements Checklist and Abstract of Bids are hereto attached as Annexes "S" and "T", respectively;


WHEREAS, ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated was given a period of three (3) calendar days within which to file its request for reconsideration of the decision of the BAC to hold the bid of ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated ineligible to bid relative to the computation of its Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) pursuant to Section 55.1 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184;

WHEREAS, on 06 June 2016, ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated filed its request for reconsideration relative to the decision of the BAC to hold said bidder ineligible to bid for its failure to comply with Section 23.5.2.6 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 (Computation of the Net Financial Contracting Capacity [NFCC]). Copy of the request for reconsideration is hereto attached as Annex "U";

WHEREAS, ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated in its request for reconsideration argued that the error in the computation was a result of a mere typographical error and the BAC should have considered the computation of its NFCC compliant since after correcting its mistake, particularly the erroneous figures reflecting its current assets, its NFCC is more than the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for the procurement of starter toolkits for the Special Training for Employment Program (STEP) for FY 2016 – Phase II;

WHEREAS, ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated cited in its request for reconsideration a Non-Policy Opinion of the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) [NPM 008-2014] issued on 28 March 2014 which opines that bidders shall be deemed compliant with the requirement on NFCC if the submitted NFCC computation is at least equal to the ABC despite the fact that the entries in the NFCC computation were figures mistakenly lifted from the Audited Financial Statements (AFS) of the bidder. A copy of the Non-Policy Opinion (NPM) of the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) [NPM 008-2014] is hereto attached as Annex "V";

WHEREAS, the BAC took the liberty of verifying the position of ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated by checking the provisions of Republic Act No. 9184 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations. Said law mandates the BAC to verify, validate and ascertain that the bidder's NFCC among others can sustain the operating cash flow of the transaction (Section 34.3 [c] of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184). The BAC is also allowed by law to consider computational errors and omissions to enable proper



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comparison of eligible bids (Section 32.2.1 [b] of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184);

WHEREAS, the BAC convened on 08 June 2016 at 10:05 a.m. at the CSA Conference Room located at the 2nd Floor of the TESDA Administration Building, Taguig City relative to the request for reconsideration of ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated. A copy of the Minutes of the Meeting is hereto attached as Annex "W";

WHEREAS, in view of the meritorious request for reconsideration dated 06 June 2016 of ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated, the BAC unanimously granted its request for reconsideration in its letter dated 08 June 2016 and pointed out that the recomputed NFCC of ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated is undoubtedly higher than the ABC for this procurement since the mistake committed was too "minimal". Likewise, the GPPB supported the position of the bidder that the bidder is compliant for as long as the NFCC after recomputation is equal to or higher than the ABC. The BAC scheduled the opening of the second (2nd) envelope of the bidder on 13 June 2016 at 2:00 p.m. at the CSA Conference Room located at the 2nd Floor of the TESDA Administration Building., Taguig City. A copy of the letter dated 08 June 2016 granting the request for reconsideration of ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated is hereto attached as Annex "X";

WHEREAS, the BAC issued a letter to ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated and made a clarification to avoid confusion insofar as the 3rd paragraph of the letter of the BAC to the bidder dated 08 June 2016 is concerned where the figures indicated were Php243,268,889.33 and Php243,268,899.33 instead of Php234,268,889.33 and Php234,268,899.33. A copy of the letter dated 09 June 2016 to ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated is hereto attached as Annex "Y";

WHEREAS, the BAC convened on 13 June 2016 at 2:05 p.m. at the CSA Conference Room located at the 2nd Floor of the TESDA Administration Building, Taguig City for the continuation of the opening of bids of ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated. A copy of the Minutes of the Meeting is hereto attached as Annex "Z";

WHEREAS, ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated passed the eligibility requirements pursuant to Sections 23 and 25 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184. A copy of the Eligibility Requirements Checklist and Abstract of Bids are hereto attached as Annexes "AA" and "BB", respectively;

WHEREAS, since the bidding is done by lot, the BAC shall evaluate the bid offer of the participating bidder by lot;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34 of Rule X (Post-Qualification) of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, verification and validation of the bidder's legal documentary requirements must be made. As such, the Chairperson of the TEG issued letters to Metropolitan Bank and Trust Company for the validation of the bank guarantee submitted by ACMI Office System

Philippines, Incorporated and to the Accounts Receivable Monitoring Division of the Bureau Internal Revenue (BIR) for the validation of the tax clearances issued by said office to ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated. Copies of the letters are hereto attached as Annexes "CC" and "DD", respectively;

WHEREAS, the abovementioned companies/offices had issued their respective confirmation letters regarding the documents submitted by ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated for the procurement of starter toolkits for the Special Training for Employment Program (STEP) for FY 2016 – Phase II. Copies of the confirmation letters of the Metropolitan Bank and Trust Company and Accounts Receivable Monitoring Division of the Bureau Internal Revenue (BIR) are hereto attached as Annexes "EE", and "FF", respectively;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 25.2.a (iv) (7) of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 which requires prospective bidders or its duly authorized representatives to submit a sworn statement in the form prescribed by the GPPB that it complies with existing labor laws and standards, compliance by the bidders with the foregoing shall be supported with the clearances or certifications from the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), Social Security System (SSS), Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth), Pag-IBIG Fund and National Labor Relations Commission (NLRC). Clearances must be issued at least within three (3) months from the date of bid opening. This is pursuant to GPPB Circular No. 01-2008 issued on 07 March 2008 giving the procuring entity the discretion whether to require the clearances from the bidders;

WHEREAS, ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated submitted during the bid opening a certification dated 22 April 2016 from the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) certifying that it has no pending case before said office in compliance with the eligibility requirements prescribed under Section III of Bid Data Sheet, Clause 5.1 (4), page 32 of the bidding documents. Copy of the foregoing certificate is hereto attached as Annex "GG";

WHEREAS, ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated submitted a certification dated 17 May 2016 from the National Labor Relations Commission (NLRC) certifying that it has no pending case before said office. Copy of the certificate issued by NLRC is hereto attached as Annex "HH";

WHEREAS, ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated submitted a clearance dated 04 May 2016 certifying that ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated has remitted the contribution of its employees from June 1998 to March 2016 and has no pending case with Social Security System (SSS). Copy of the certificate issued by SSS is hereto attached as Annex "II";

WHEREAS, ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated submitted a certification dated 03 May 2016 from the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) that it has remitted premium contributions of its employees from January 2009 to February 2016. Copy of the certificate issued by PhilHealth is hereto attached as Annex "JJ";

WHEREAS, ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated submitted a certification that it has remitted contributions of its employees from August 1998 to April 2016 and has no pending case with Pag-IBIG Fund. Copy of the certificate issued by Pag-IBIG is hereto attached as Annex "KK";

WHEREAS, the Chairperson of the TEG issued letters to Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), Social Security System (SSS), Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth), Pag-IBIG Fund and National Labor Relations Commission (NLRC) for the validation of the documents issued by said offices to ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated. Copies of the documents are hereto attached as Annexes "LL", "MM", "NN", "OO" and "PP";

WHEREAS, the abovementioned government agencies had issued their respective confirmation regarding the clearances/certifications submitted by ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated for the procurement of starter toolkits for the Special Training for Employment Program (STEP) for FY 2016 – Phase II. Copies of the confirmation of the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), Social Security System (SSS), Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth), Pag-IBIG Fund and National Labor Relations Commission (NLRC) are hereto attached as Annexes "QQ", "RR", "SS", "TT" and "UU", respectively;

WHEREAS, the TEG in its report found the bid offered by ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated to be compliant with the legal, technical and financial requirements set forth by the agency pursuant to Section 34 of Rule X (Post-Qualification) of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184. A copy of the TEG report is hereto attached as Annex "VV";

WHEREAS, according to the report of the Technical Evaluation Group (TEG), the BAC hereby resolves to adopt its findings and recommendations by way of recommending the award of the contract on a per lot basis to the bidders as follows:

WHEREAS, the Notice of Post-Disqualification dated 21 June 2016 was received by ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated on 21 June 2016 and the period within which to file a request for reconsideration had already lapsed without the bidder having filed any request for reconsideration pursuant to Section 55.1 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 36 (a) of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, if after advertisement, only one prospective bidder applies for eligibility check, meets the requirements and submits a bid which is found to be responsive to the bidding requirements, its bid is considered a Single Calculated and Responsive Bid;

WHEREAS, ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated met all the eligibility requirements prescribed by the agency and its bid had been found to be responsive to the bidding requirements. Hence, the BAC finds the bid of ACMI Office System Philippines, Incorporated to be the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to declare a failure of bidding on Lot 34 (Perform Hand Spa [Leading to Beauty Care NC II]) and to recommend the award of the contracts to ACMI Office System

Philippines, Incorporated considering that its bid had been found to be the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid for the procurement of starter toolkits for the Special Training for Employment Program (STEP) for FY 2016 – Phase II on a per lot basis as follows:


