Pursuant to Section 22.5 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 and in Section 4.3.2.2 of National Budget Circular No. 580 dated 22 April 2020 issued by the Department of Budget and Management (DBM), the following items in the Bidding Documents are hereby amended as follows:

ORIGINAL AMENDED Section I. Invitation to Bid

The Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), through the General Appropriations Act (GAA) CY 2020 intends to apply the sum of Four Hundred Fifty-Three Million Four Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-Six Pesos and 50/100 (P4,453,966.50) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payment under the contract for the Procurement of Fuel and Lubricants (Gasoline and Diesel) Through Fuel Card System for the TESDA Central Office Service Vehicles for FY 2020 - Rebidding. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

Technical Education and The Development Authority (TESDA), through the General Appropriations Act (GAA) CY 2020 intends to apply the sum of Two Million Eight Hundred Sixteen Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-Eight Pesos and 40/100 (P2,816,898.40) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payment under the contract for the Procurement of Fuel and Lubricants (Gasoline and Diesel) Through Fuel Card System for the TESDA Central Office Service Vehicles for FY 2020 -Rebidding. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

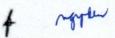

The service station/branch of the Fuel and Lubricants Provider shall load fuel only to the authorized vehicle as indicated in the fuel card or to a TESDA service vehicle whose fuel card holder operates/uses several TESDA service vehicles.	
The service station/branch of the Fuel and Lubricants Provider shall issue transaction slip/receipt/invoice every time fuel and/or lubricant is withdrawn.	
The Statement of Account should be accurate with the receipt /invoice issued by the service station/branch.	
Have fully enrolled all users in the fuel card system and delivered the fuel cards within fifteen (15) calendar days from the receipt of Notice to Proceed.	
Have conducted orientation on the use of the fuel card within seven (7) calendar days from the time the fuel cards are delivered to TESDA.	
Must submit a list of service stations with corresponding location which has a fuel card system facility.	
Must bill TESDA with the actual consumption within the agreed period so as not to hamper operations of TESDA service vehicles.

Statements of "Comply" or "Not Comply" must be supported by evidence in a Bidders Bid and cross-referenced to that evidence. Evidence shall be in the form of manufacturer's un-amended sales literature, unconditional statements of specification and compliance issued by the manufacturer, samples, independent test data etc., as appropriate. A statement that is not supported by evidence or is subsequently found to be contradicted by the evidence presented will render the Bid under evaluation liable for rejection. A statement either in the Bidders statement of compliance or the supporting evidence that is found to be false either during Bid evaluation, post-qualification or the execution of the Contract may be regarded as fraudulent and render the



Bidder or supplier liable for prosecution subject to the provisions of ITB Clause 3.1 (a)(ii) and/or GCC Clause 2.1(a)(ii).

I hereby certify that the statement of compliance to the foregoing technical specifications are true and correct, otherwise, if found to be false either during bid evaluation or post-qualification, the same shall give rise to automatic disqualification of our bid.
