

TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TVET STATISTICS

For the year 2024, the total target enrollment for regions, as determined in the output of the 18th General Directorate Conference, is 1,365,310. As of this quarter, 18.09% of the target enrollment and 18.60% of the target graduates have been achieved. This marks an 11% increase in enrollment and a 10% increase in graduates compared to the previous 1st quarter accomplishment of 2023.

In terms of regional achievement, TESDA Region II leads with the highest percentages of target enrollment and graduates, at 38.24% and 35.44%, respectively. Following closely is Region X with 27.60% enrollment and 26.31% graduates, and TESDA Region IX with 25.91% enrollment and 21.34% graduates. These regions are on track to achieve 100% of their targets by year-end, given that they have already surpassed 25% of their targets in the first quarter alone.

Regarding gender distribution as of March 2024, 52.40% of enrolled individuals are female, while 47.60% are male. For graduates, 51.15% are female, and 48.85% are male.

TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TVET STATISTICS

For the 1st quarter, around 25% of the target for assessment and certification has been recorded, which is approximately 11% higher than the 1st quarter output from 2023. This indicates a strong possibility of achieving 100% of the total target for the year 2024.

In terms of regional accomplishment relative to the regional target, TESDA NCR has the highest achievement for both assessed and certified individuals, with 57.62% and 61.07%, respectively. This is followed by TESDA Region III (31%) and TESDA Region XI (27%), in both assessment and certification.

For the certification rate, TESDA NCR still has the highest rate at 98.04%, followed closely by TESDA Region VIII at 97.91%, and TESDA Region VII at 95.98%.

Moreover, unlike the number of female and male enrollees and graduates, there is an inverse trend in the number of assessed and certified individuals, with more males taking the assessment than females, showing a difference of 5%.

For the 1st quarter of 2024, the institution-based training programs recorded the highest number of enrollees, accounting for 46.09% of the total, and graduates, accounting for 52.17% of the total output. This is followed by community-based training programs, which achieved around 38% for both enrollees and graduates.

In terms of regional accomplishments by delivery mode, the larger regions still have the highest number of enrollees for institution-based training. TESDA NCR leads with 17.25%, followed by TESDA Region IV-A with 10.54%, and TESDA Region III with 7.77% of the total enrolled.

For enterprise-based training, TESDA Region VIII leads with a 15.58% share, followed closely by TESDA Region X with 13.31% and TESDA Region IV-B with 11.52%.

For community-based training, TESDA NCR leads with a total of 14.45%, followed by TESDA Region III with 11.09%, and TESDA Region II with 8.56%.

In terms of the number of graduates by delivery mode, TESDA NCR has the highest total graduates among all regions, totaling 36,775. On the other hand, CARAGA and BARMM have the lowest number of graduates, with a significant reliance on community-based and institution-based training, respectively.

Further, among all delivery modes, institution-based training is the most utilized across most regions. Community-based training also shows a significant number of graduates, indicating its importance in certain regions, especially CAR and Region IV-A.

Moreover, in terms of gender distribution, there is a relatively balanced distribution among graduates, with females slightly outnumbering males.

In terms of enrollment distribution by sector, Agriculture, Forestry and Fishery, and Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) have the highest numbers, with 45,307 (18.34%) and 45,133 (18.27%) enrolled, respectively, followed by the Social, Community Development, and Other Services sector, which has 28,010 enrollments (11.34%).

Regarding graduates, Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) continues to lead with 46,973 graduates (20.55%), followed by Automotive and Land Transportation with 24,587 graduates (10.76%), and Social, Community Development, and Other Services with 24,147 graduates (10.56%). Note that the number of graduates includes spillovers from the 2022 enrollees.

Furthermore, as the table shows, the Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) sector has the highest number of enrolled and graduated students, with a notable gender balance. The Social, Community Development, and Other Services sector also has a significant number of enrollments and graduates. Conversely, the Chemicals / Plastics / Petrochemicals sector has low numbers, with 151 enrollments and graduates. The Furniture and Fixtures sector also has low numbers, with 45 enrollments and 32 graduates. Decorative Crafts, with 131 enrollments and graduates.

In terms of gender distribution, the Human Health / Health Care sector is predominantly female, with 74.92% enrolled and 71.75% graduated. The Automotive and Land Transportation sector is predominantly male, with 73.66% enrolled and 74.16% graduated. Similarly, the Construction sector is predominantly male, with 84.61% enrolled and 83.04% graduated.

In terms of assessment and certification, the Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) sector has the highest number of individuals assessed, with 74,443 (29.93%), and 71,017 certified (30.19%), resulting in a certification rate of 95.35%. This is followed by the Automotive and Land Transportation sector, with 31,303 (12.58%) assessed and 29,962 (12.74%) certified, achieving a certification rate of 95.72%. The Social, Community Development, and Other Services sector had 30,954 (12.44%) assessed and 29,056 (12.35%) certified, indicating a certification rate of 93.87%.

For the first quarter, Private TVET Providers recorded the highest numbers in both enrollment and graduates, accounting for around 53% of the total output. In terms of gender distribution, both Private and Public TVET providers have higher numbers of female enrollees compared to male enrollees. However, among graduates from Private TVET providers, there is a slight difference, with more male graduates than female. Moreover, the completion rates for both Private and Public TVET providers are around 92%.

As the Tourism sector has been one of the sectors with the highest number of enrollments and graduates over the past few years, it is expected that it also has the most assessment centers (2,498) and competency assessors (3,523) to cater the graduates and walk-in for assessments. This is directly proportional to the number of competency assessors. Following Tourism, the Construction sector has 1,264 assessment centers and 1,902 competency assessors, the Automotive and Land Transportation sector has 850 assessment centers and 1,667 competency assessors, and the Agriculture, Forestry, and Fishery sector has 889 assessment centers and 1,666 competency assessors.

In terms of Scholarship Program Output, there are a total of 109,074 enrolled and 11,592 graduates across all scholarship programs. Among these, TWSP has the highest number of enrollments, with 44,936 (41.20% of the total). This is followed by UAQTEA with 21,497 enrollments (19.41%), and RESP with 20,524 enrollment (18.82%).

For regions with the highest scholarship output, Region VIII leads with 12,664 enrollments, primarily from UAQTEA (41.01%). This is followed by Region IV-A with 11,241 enrollments, where TWSP (60.99%) has the highest number of enrollments. Region XII follows with 9,309 enrollments, with the majority coming from TWSP (42.10%) and RESP (33.03%).

As of March 2024, there are a total of 17,902 registered programs, comprising various TVET programs. Region III has the highest number of registered programs with 2,027, followed by Region IV-A with 1,696, and NCR with 1,573 registered programs.

In terms of newly registered programs from January to March 31, 2024, there are a total of 748 newly registered programs. Similarly, Region III leads with 110 newly registered programs, followed by Region VII with 74, and Region I with 68 newly registered programs.

Similar to other sectoral distributions, the Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) and Agriculture, Forestry, and Fishery sectors have the highest number of registered programs, with 4,288 (23.95%) and 3,183 (17.78%) of the total, respectively. These are followed by the Metals and Engineering and Construction sectors.

As of March 2024, private TVET providers (90.35%) significantly outnumber public TVET providers (9.65%).
