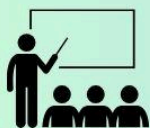

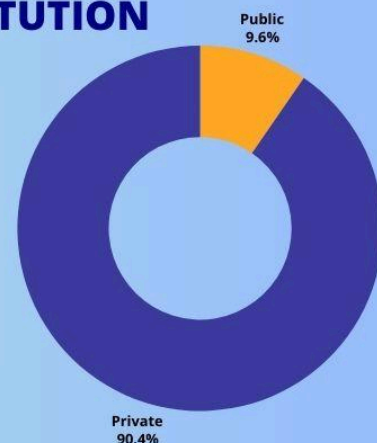

As of this quarter, 76.83% of the target enrollment and 80.24% of the target graduates have been achieved, approximately a 30% increase from the previous quarter.

In terms of regional accomplishments, all regions have exceeded 50% of their respective targets. Notably, Region II leads with the highest percentages of target enrollment and graduates, achieving 125.98% and 128.72%, respectively. Following closely are Region X, with 110.53% enrollment and 125.74% graduates, and Region IX, with 101.07% enrollment and 102.17% graduates.

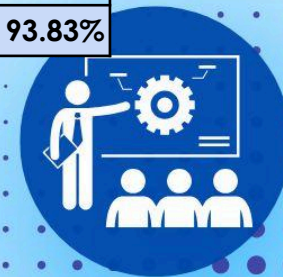
Regarding gender distribution as of September 2024, 51.42% of enrolled individuals are female, while 48.58% are male. Similarly, for graduates, 51.47% are female, and 48.53% are male.

For the 3rd quarter, 96.88% of the target for assessment and 98.25% of the target for certification have been achieved, marking an approximately 30% increase compared to the 2nd quarter output of 2024.

In terms of regional accomplishments relative to regional targets, NCR recorded the highest achievement for both assessed and certified individuals, followed by Region II and Region X.

The national certification rate for the 3rd quarter stands at 93.3%. Among the regions, NCR achieved the highest certification rate at 97.74%, followed closely by Region VIII at 96.64%, and BARMM at 91.68%.

Moreover, in contrast to the gender distribution observed among enrollees and graduates, there is an inverse trend in the number of assessed and certified individuals, with 54% of assessments taken by males, while 46% only of females.

As of this quarter, institution-based training programs continue to have the highest number of enrollees, accounting for 49.68% of the total, with a 1.45% growth compared to the previous quarter. Similarly, institution-based training programs account for 51.06% of the total graduates.

This is followed by community-based training programs, which achieved 36.54% of enrollees and 35.81% of graduates. Meanwhile, the enterprise-based training program recorded an 8.89% share of enrollees and an 8.28% share of graduates.

For institution-based training, NCR recorded the highest number of enrollees at 16.13%, followed by Region IV-A with 9.64% and Region III with 9.43% of the total enrolled.

For enterprise-based training, Region X leads with a 9.29% share, followed closely by Region VIII with 9.13% and Region IV-B with 8.80% of the total enrolled.

For community-based training, Region III achieved the highest share at 16.01%, followed by NCR with 9.92% and Region XII with 8.56% of the total enrolled.

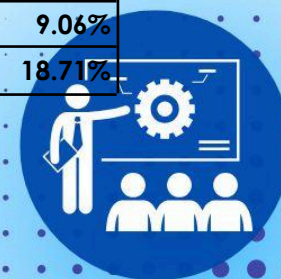

In terms of enrollment distribution by sector, Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) and Agriculture, Forestry and Fishery have the highest percentage share, with 18.61% and 15.72% of the total enrolled, respectively. This is followed by the Social, Community Development, and Other Services sector, with a 9.67% share.

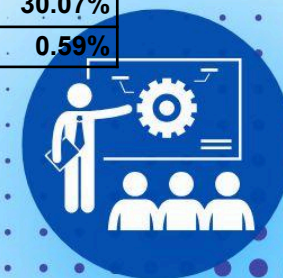
Regarding graduates, Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) continues to lead with 18.71% share of the total graduates, followed by Agriculture, Forestry and Fishery with 15.67%, and Social, Community Development, and Other Services sector with 9.06%. Note that the number of graduates includes spillovers from the 2023 enrollees.

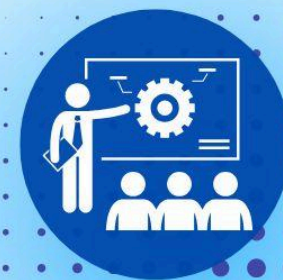

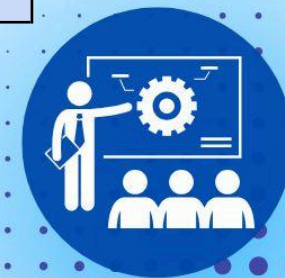

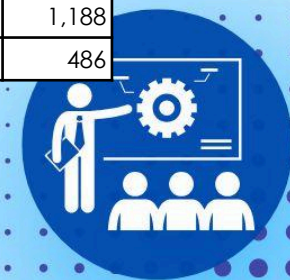

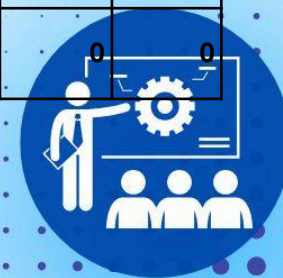
