





For the year 2024, the total target enrollment for regions, as determined in the output of the 18th General Directorate Conference, is 1,365,310 for enrollment and 1,228,779 for graduates. As of this quarter, 47.00% and 50.10% or almost half of the target enrollment and graduates have been achieved.

In terms of regional achievement, Region II leads with the highest percentages of target enrollment and graduates, at 89.32% and 87.67%, respectively. Following closely is Region X with 78.05% enrollment and 87.89% graduates, and Region IX with 66.10% enrollment and 68.87% graduates. These regions are on track to achieve 100% of their targets by year-end, given that they have already surpassed 50% of their targets in the second quarter.

Regarding gender distribution as of June 2024, 51.66% of enrolled individuals are female, while 48.33% are male. For graduates, 51.18% are female, and 48.82% are male.




For the 2nd quarter, around 67% of the target for assessment and certification has been recorded, which is approximately 42% higher than the 1st quarter output of 2024.

In terms of regional accomplishment relative to the regional target, NCR has the highest achievement for both assessed and certified individuals, with 137.85% and 145.59%, respectively. This is followed by Region II, 82% in both assessment and certification and TRegion X with 77.10% in assessment and 75.60% in certification.

For the certification rate, the national certification rate recorded is 93.75%, while in terms of regional certification rate NCR has the highest rate at 97.69%, followed closely by Region VIII at 97.01%, and Region XII at 94.79%.

Moreover, unlike the number of female and male enrollees and graduates, there is an inverse trend in the number of assessed and certified individuals, with more males taking the assessment than females, showing a difference of 14%.



In terms of training implementation by delivery mode, the institution-based training programs obtained the highest share in enrolled, accounting for 48.23% of the total, and graduates with 51.30% of the total. This is followed by community-based training programs, which achieved 35.04% and 33.91 for both enrollees and graduates. The enterprise-based training program has a 9.73% share in enrolled, and 8.03% share in graduates. The significant percentage share of institution-based programs can be attributed to the number of TVET providers or training institutions with registered programs with TESDA, compared to the providers of enterprise-based training programs, which remains to be low.

On the other hand, the large percentage share of the community-based training programs can be attributed to the programs conducted in partnership with the Local Government Units, including the implementation of the Special Training for Employment Program (STEP). While the number of beneficiaries under the enterprise-based training program remains to be low, the Agency is determined to work on mechanisms that will contribute to increasing the number of participating companies and enterprises that will deliver the corresponding TVET programs through Enterprise-Based Training.



In terms of regional accomplishments by delivery mode, the larger regions still have the highest number of enrollees for institution-based training. NCR leads with 16.48%, followed by Region IV-A with 9.26%, and Region III with 8.65% of the total enrolled.

For enterprise-based training, Region IV-B leads with a 10.34% share, followed closely by Region X with 10.26% and Region VIII with 10.14% of the total enrolled.

For community-based training, Region III leads with a total of 11.95%, followed by NCR with 11.68%, and Region XII with 9.78% of the total enrolled.


In terms of the number of graduates by delivery mode, NCR has the highest total graduates among all regions, with 13.41% share. On the other hand, BARMM and CARAGA have the lowest number of graduates. Community-based training graduates contributed to the outputs of CARAGA, while BARMM's outputs come from the graduates of institution-based training.

Further, among all delivery modes, institution-based training is the most utilized across most regions. Community-based training also shows a significant number of graduates, indicating its importance in certain regions, especially CAR and Region IV-A.

In terms of enrollment distribution by sector, Agriculture, Forestry and Fishery, and Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) have the highest percentage share, with 17.81% and 18.72% of the total enrolled, respectively. This is followed by the Social, Community Development, and Other Services sector, with a 9.26% share.

Regarding graduates, Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) continues to lead with 19.38% share of the total graduates, followed by Agriculture, Forestry and Fishery with 15.49%, and Automotive and Land Transportation with 9.03%. Note that the number of graduates includes spillovers from the 2023 enrollees.

In terms of gender distribution, there are significant gender disparities in enrollment within various sectors. The Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) and Human Health / Health Care sector are predominantly female, with 75.11% and 67.45%. Likewise, the Automotive and Land Transportation and the Construction sectors are predominantly male, with 74.92% and 84% shares, respectively. This trend could be attributed to gender stereotypes in sectors such as tourism and health care. These roles often include housekeeping, front office services, food and beverage handling, cooking, personal care aides, home health aides, and nursing assistants. Conversely, male enrollment is predominant in sectors requiring physical strength, such as Construction, Automotive and Land Transportation and Electrical and Electronics sector.




In terms of assessment and certification, the Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) sector has the highest number of individuals assessed at 30.63% share, and 31.08% share in individuals certified, resulting in a certification rate of 95.11%. This is followed by the Electrical and Electronics sector, with 14.05% assessed and 13.21% certified, achieving a certification rate of 88.14%. The Social, Community Development, and Other Services sector had 10.35% assessed and 10.5% certified, indicating a certification rate of 90.97%.



For the 2nd quarter of 2024, private TVET providers recorded the highest numbers in both enrollment and graduates, accounting for around 57% of the total output. The Tourism sector has the most number of assessment centers (2,694) and competency assessors (3,512) that can cater to TVET graduates and walk-ins for assessments. This is directly proportional to the number of competency assessors. The Construction sector has the second highest number of assessment centers (1,345) and competency assessors (1,770), followed by the Automotive and Land Transportation sector with 908 assessment centers and 1,654 competency assessors. The Agriculture, Forestry, and Fishery sector has the fourth highest number of assessment centers (995) and competency assessors (1,677).

In terms of TVET Infrastructure on registered programs as of June 2024, it can be observed that there is a decrease of 207 registered programs from 17,902 in the 1st quarter to 17,695 in the 2nd Quarter. This decrease can be attributed to the programs that expired and were not renewed. On the other hand, in terms of regional accomplishment, TESDA Region III has the highest number of registered programs with 2,067, followed by Region IV-A with 1,560, and NCR with 1,465 registered programs.
