**RECOMMENDING THE APPROVAL OF THE REVISED DUAL TRAINING SYSTEM  
IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, Section 7 of Republic Act No. 7686 otherwise known as the "Dual Training System Act of 1994" signed into law on February 25, 1994 mandates the appropriate Authority to plan, set standards, coordinate, monitor and allocate resources in support of the implementation of the system;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) as recommended by the Bureau of Technical and Vocational Education (BTVE) promulgated the Rules and Regulations for the implementation of the Dual Training System Act on June 2, 1994;

**WHEREAS**, Section 5 of Republic Act No. 7796 otherwise known as the "TESDA Act of 1994" and enacted on August 25, 1994 created the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority which replaced and absorbed the National Manpower and Youth Council (NMYC), the Bureau of Technical and Vocational Education (BTVE) and the personnel and functions pertaining to technical-vocational education in the regional offices of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) and the apprenticeship program of the Bureau of Local Employment of the Department of Labor and Employment;

**WHEREAS**, Section 8 of Republic Act No. 7796 otherwise known as "TESDA Act of 1994" mandates the Authority to primarily be responsible for formulating, continuing, coordinated and fully integrated technical education and skills development policies, plans and programs;

**WHEREAS**, the Partnerships and Linkages Office of TESDA, being the focal office for Enterprise-based Training Programs, drafted the revised Dual Training System-Implementing Rules and Regulations (DTS-IRR) incorporating the inputs from industry partners, technical and vocational schools, concerned National Government Agencies, and associations/organizations,

On its 10<sup>th</sup> meeting, the Committee favorably recommended to the TESDA Board the endorsement of the DTS-IRR for approval of the TESDA Board;
