**APPROVING AND PROMULGATING THE TRAINING REGULATIONS FOR  
TOUR PACKAGING (FIT AD HOC DOMESTIC) SERVICES NC II**

**WHEREAS**, Section 14 (b) of Republic Act No. 7796 mandates that TESDA shall develop and establish a national system of skills standardization, testing and certification and conduct research and development on various occupational areas in order to recommend policies, rules and regulations for effective and efficient skills standardization, testing and certification system in the country;

**WHEREAS**, the **Tourism Industry Board Foundation Inc. (TIBFI)** is the lead industry organization in the Tourism Sector and known provider of the expertise needed for the industry;

**WHEREAS**, the **Tourism Industry Board Foundation, Inc. (TIBFI)** in partnership with Department of Tourism (DOT), with the assistance of Qualifications and Standards Office (QSO) of TESDA has developed the Training Regulations in Tour Packaging (FIT AD HOC DOMESTIC) Services NC II in view of the implementation of Mutual Recognition Arrangement (MRA) for Tourism qualifications in the ASEAN Region;

**WHEREAS**, the **Tourism Industry Board Foundation, Inc. (TIBFI)** initiated the development of the Training Regulations (TRs) for Tour Packaging (FIT AD HOC DOMESTIC) Services NC II with the assistance of Qualifications and Standards Office (QSO);

**WHEREAS**, the scope of work of the new TRs for Tour Packaging (FIT AD HOC DOMESTIC) Services NC II involve in interpreting and responding to requests for independent tour services, designing and developing tour package itinerary, and determining tour package cost and selling price;

**WHEREAS**, industry experts and partners, headed by the Chair of Tourism Industry Board Foundation Inc. (TIBFI), with the technical assistance of the Qualifications and Standards Office (QSO) of TESDA have developed and endorsed the same for TESDA Board Approval;

**WHEREAS**, during the 105<sup>th</sup> Standards-Setting and Systems Development (SSSD) Committee Meeting held on November 22, 2018, the Committee deliberated upon and favorably recommended to the TESDA Board the promulgation of the Training Regulations for Tour Packaging (FIT AD HOC DOMESTIC) Services NC II;

**WHEREAS**, during the 107<sup>th</sup> TESDA Board Meeting on 11 January 2019 at 9:00 a.m., the TESDA Board considered and approved the promulgation of the Training Regulations for Tour Packaging (FIT AD HOC DOMESTIC) Services NC II;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, that the TESDA Board in its meeting today, 11 January 2019 at 9:00 a.m., approves and promulgates the aforementioned Training Regulations for Tour Packaging (FIT AD HOC DOMESTIC) Services NC II as herein appended;

**BE IT RESOLVED, FINALLY**, that:

(1) Copies of this Resolution and the abovementioned Training Regulations be published in the Official Gazette and one (1) newspaper of general circulation, and disseminated to all concerned, and the same shall be effective fifteen (15) days upon publication;

(2) All programs to be registered under these new Training Regulations must comply with the requirements of the aforementioned Training Regulations. The registration under this new Training Regulations shall commence on the date of effectivity as indicated in the Implementing Guidelines/ TESDA Circular for the deployment of the Training Regulations to be issued by the TESDA Secretariat; and

(3) Graduates of TVET programs covered by the aforementioned Training Regulations shall be required to undergo mandatory assessment under the national assessment and certification program.
